SUBJECT: Dress Standards for Wagon Wheel Dining Facility

1. In accordance with AFI 36-2903, Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel, all personnel will adhere to the following guidelines set forth for dress and personal appearance as patrons of the Mountain Home Air Force Base Wagon Wheel Dining Facility. Civilian attire will reflect good taste and compare favorably with attire worn in similar off-base restaurants. The purpose of the dress code is to provide a healthy, sanitary, and comfortable atmosphere for all personnel.
2. The following civilian clothing and personal standards will be strictly enforced:
 - a. No sleeveless shirts, muscle shirts, tank tops, cropped tops, “fishnet” shirts, or see-through shirts
 - b. No bare feet or slippers (flip flops, sandals, and open-toed shoes are permitted)
 - c. No clothing that is excessively torn, tattered, or frayed
 - d. No soiled, dirty, or clothing that is saturated with perspiration from physical exercise/activity
 - e. No clothing that bears discriminatory, obscene, drug-promoting, or sexually suggestive designs, slogans, or patches
 - f. No clothing specifically designed as or appearing to be undergarments, no sleepwear
 - g. No use of headphones or mobile devices while on the serving line
3. Enforcement of this dress code is delegated to the on-duty shift leader of the Wagon Wheel Dining Facility. If you have any questions, please contact Dining Facility Management at 728-4053/2313/4239.
